Approval of Minutes

- Betsy moved, Sean seconded.
- Minutes approved unanimously. Katy and Emily abstained due to absence.

Financial Update & Budget Process

- Some adjustments still to come, but we are looking at a \$400,000 deficit at the moment, which is roughly \$200,000 larger than budgeted.
- Main areas of loss are grant and rental revenue being lower than projected.
- 2024 budget templates going out to department heads tomorrow morning.
- Finance team is assembling a three-year forecast that will be part of the budget process this year.

Approval of Housing Allowances

- Amy McCreath: \$28,000
- Tamra Tucker: \$15,000
- Jane moved to approve the housing allowances. Hall seconded.
- Motion approved unanimously. Rebecca abstained.

Strategic Plan Revision Process

- Questions for consideration:
 - o How has the context within which we carry out our mission changed since the summer of 2020?
 - How have our stakeholders changed? For whom does it matter that we exist and carry out this mission?
 - O What do we know and what more do we need to know in order to make faithful, informed decisions about what needs revising in the plan?
- Breakout room review of current strategic plan
 - Jane: context has changed. So have stakeholders, and perhaps for the better.
 Cathedral can serve an important function in terms of supporting parishes.
 - o Jen: it's clear that we need support from outside our congregations. We need to think creatively about how to do that.

- o Amy: we face challenging changes in the world. We're becoming aware of the growing divide in our country. Especially, there are many young adults who bring deep commitments to equity and great awareness of the world's needs.
- We will return to these questions at future meetings, and perform this same exercise with staff.
- Volunteers for ad hoc planning team
 - o Amy would welcome those interested in helping to scope out this process.
