- There are two concerts on December 16<sup>th</sup> and April 13<sup>th</sup>, and a Christmas play on December 23<sup>rd</sup>. All of these events take place at 4 pm
- The annual Messiah Sing is a popular civic event. This year the Messiah Sing is on Wednesday, December 20<sup>th</sup>. Scores are provided.
